

MINI BACCARAT / LUCKY 8 BACCARAT

Baccarat is an elegant, simple game to play. There are only two decisions you have to make in the game. How much you want to bet, and whether to bet on the Bank or the Player. If you want to bet on the Bank, the casino will collect a 5% vigorish or commission charge on all the money won. The small circle to the right of the Banker betting area is to place the 5% commission prior to the hand being dealt or paid.

The commission must be paid at the conclusion of each hand.

An additional bet you may make is a bet on the tie (that two "hands" will end in equal totals.)

A winning tie bet pays 8 to 1.

THE GAME

Baccarat is played with eight full decks of cards. The cards are shuffled by the Dealer and placed in a box called a shoe. All cards count as face value. Ace equals one. Deuce equals two. All tens and face cards or any combination of them have no value. So: 9 + 5 = 4. Jack + Ace = 1.

The game begins when four (4) cards are dealt alternately from the shoe. First card to the Player, second card to the Bank, third to the Player and fourth to the Bank. If the point count of either hand is 8 or 9, it is called a "natural" and no additional cards are drawn. If the Bank does not have a natural, the Player will always draw a third card on totals of 0-1-2-3-4 and 5 and stand with 6-7-8 and 9. The cards are dealt according to fixed rules. There are no options regarding drawing the third card for either Player's or Banker's hand. No more than one additional card will be drawn to each hand. The hand closest to 9 wins and shall be paid at odds of 1 to 1.

If both the Player's hand and the Banker's hand result in identical totals, it is a tie and neither hand wins or loses.

These charts describe the fixed rules governing the drawing of additional cards.

RULES: PLAYER

When the first two cards total:	0-1-2-3-4-5	Draws
	6-7	Stands
	8-9	Natural Stands

RULES: BANKER

When the Player stands on 6 or 7, then the Banker will always draw on totals of 0-1-2-3-4 and 5, and stand on 6-7-8 and 9.

When the Player does not have a natural, the Banker shall always draw on the totals of 0-1 or 2 and then observe the following rules:

When first two cards total:

Banker Having	Draws When Player's Third Card is:	Does Not Draw When Player's Third Card is:
3	1-2-3-4-5-6-7-9-10	8
4	2-3-4-5-6-7	1-8-9-10
5	4-5-6-7	1-2-3-8-9-10
6	6-7	1-2-3-4-5-8-9-10
7	Stands	
8-9	Natural - Neither Hand Draws	



MINI BACCARAT / LUCKY 8 BACCARAT

Lucky 8 is an optional bonus bet used in the game of Mini Baccarat.

All rules pertaining to standard Mini Baccarat will remain identical.

Players may place a wager on either the Player hand or the Banker hand.

Players may also place a wager on the tie bet alone.

In addition, players may place a Lucky 8 Bonus wager on the Player's hand, the Banker's hand, or both. Of the possible four betting options, the players are permitted to play three. Lucky 8 Bonus wagers placed on the Banker's hand and on the Player's hand may be of unequal value.

All wagers must be made before any cards have been revealed.

To win the Lucky 8 wager, the corresponding that was bet must equal a point value of 8 (as determined in the standard rules of Mini Baccarat).

Winning wagers are paid as follows:

<u>Player Hand / Banker Hand</u>	<u>Pays</u>
Double Suited 8 (both hands = 8; consists of 3 cards each)	200 to 1
Suited 8 (hand value = 8; 3 suited cards)	25 to 1
Double 8 (both hands = 8)	15 to 1
Unlucky 8 (hand value = 8; opposing hand = 9)	8 to 1
Lucky 8 (hand value = 8)	4 to 1

The maximum wager amount is \$300.

\$30,000 Maximum payout per round of play.

No side betting allowed. Management decisions are final.
